Tab Summary Notes:

Coin-Flip Results:

High/Low Coin-Flip

Key: Heads = High, Tails = Low

Result: **Heads**; therefore higher team number gets the higher ranking (if tied).

Round #3 Flip for Rights to Plaintiff

Key: Heads = Prosecution on the Left (Odds); Tails = Prosecution on the Right (Evens)

Result: **Heads**; therefore left-side/odd numbered teams are Prosecution

Challenges

In the Round #1 Matchup between 1306 v. 1506, the teams alleged that the Presiding Judge did NOT score throughout the round and simply "copied" the Second Judge's scores. As the only remedy would be not counting his scores and duplicating his scores (which was the result nonetheless), no AMTA Intervention was necessary.

Other Notes

Going into Round #4, 8th Place had 3.5 Ballots (7 teams); therefore the "In/Out" range was 1.5-6 Ballots.
