

Call for Proposals to Host the 2013 National Championship Tournament

The American Mock Trial Association is receiving proposals from those interested in hosting the 2013 National Championship Tournament. Any such proposals should include at least:

- A cover letter from you as the primary contact person indicating a desire to host the tournament;
- A preferred date for the event (and alternative dates that might be available to you);
- The location of the tournament and a description of the facilities (i.e., is it an on-campus event, at a law school, some hybrid of the two?);
- Ideally, some assurance from a courthouse administrator and/or on-campus administrator that the facilities will be available for the tournament (i.e., the you are authorized to use the facilities);
- The availability of hotels and restaurants (a list of potential places);
- The availability of transportation in-and-out of your community and in-and-out of the tournament site. Specifically, we would like to know about your air transportation – the nearest airport(s)?, what carriers serve that airport?, shuttle services to-and-from the airport (particularly if the closest airport is some distance away)?.
- A statement about how you plan to meet the need for judges (e.g., the number of attorneys in your region, and how you plan to recruit them);
- An indication of any support you can expect to receive from your institution, or, if appropriate outside entities who you believe will support the tournament;
- Experience in hosting invitational, regional, or national tournaments (ORCS or previous National Championship Tournaments; endorsements/testimonials are certainly welcome).
