2010 National Championship Tournament Open Bid Rankings

Pursuant to AMTA Rule 6.2, *Open Bids* are regular bids that have been declined or unreserved, and extra bids not allocated to a tournament as a regular bid. When available, open bids are awarded pursuant to Rule 6.9.

Rule 6.9 (2) lists the following series of tiebreakers that shall control the open bid rankings to the National Championship Tournament:

- (a) Ballots won at the opening round of the championship series;
- (b) Whether the school already has a team in the National Championship Tournament, with those schools without a team in the National Championship Tournament taking precedence;
- (c) Combined strength at the opening round of the championship series;
- (d) The number of teams in the team's opening round of the championship series, with the larger number taking precedence;
- (e) Bonus bid ranking, with the better ranking taking precedence.

Act of AMTA bids awarded under Rule 6.10 necessarily reduce the number of available open bids under Rule 6.9.
