

One Last Time – Alternates

There will be a limited registration period for Alternates for the One Last Time competition. Alternates are NOT guaranteed an opportunity to compete. We may assign Alternates at any time, up to and including the day of competition. After an Alternate has been offered a spot, the Alternate has 4 hours to accept. Failure to timely accept will forfeit the offered spot.

Role of Alternates:

Alternates may be offered one of two roles, as needed by the competition:

- (1) A position on the swing team. The swing team may compete as a registered team in the event that the tournament field has an uneven number of teams. This includes being “on call” on the weekend of competition if a registered team does not show up at any point.
- (2) A position on a registered team if a registered team is unable to complete their roster with four eligible competitors.

Alternate Eligibility:

Any graduated senior eligible to compete in One Last Time that has not already registered may be an Alternate. In addition, any student may be an Alternate if the student was listed on an AMTA roster for the 2020 competitive season for an institution that:

- (a) qualified for the 2020 National Championship Tournament;
- (b) qualified for the Princeton, Memphis, or Greenville Opening Round Championship Series tournaments; or
- (c) were otherwise prevented from competing at an Opening Round Championship Series tournament as a result of travel restrictions related to COVID-19.

Competing as an Alternate will not forfeit any student’s eligibility in any future AMTA seasons.

Registration of Alternates:

Alternates must register as (a) an Attorney, (b) a Witness, or (c) an Attorney and/or Witness.

Ranking of Alternate Registrants:

Alternates will be ranked on the Attorney, Witness, or Attorney/Witness lists in the below order:

- (a) Graduated Seniors who qualify as Priority Registrants
- (b) Graduated Seniors who qualify as Non-Priority Registrants
- (c) Juniors – students rostered in the 2020 season who have either 3 or more years of competitive experience or will graduate in December of 2020 or Spring/Summer of 2021
- (d) Sophomores – students rostered in the 2020 season who are have either 2 years of competitive experience or will graduate in December of 2021 or Spring/Summer of 2022
- (e) Freshmen – students rostered in the 2020 season who are have either 1 year of competitive experience or will graduate after December of 2022

The tie breaker for registrants at the same level will be time and date of registration.

Formation of the Swing Team:

The Swing Team members will be randomly selected after the close of registration, without regard to registration time/date. We will fill the swing team following the above priority ranking (first with Priority Registrants, then Non-Priority Registrants, then Juniors, etc.) until complete.
