

One Last Time Mock Trial Tournament Eligibility Requirements

Purpose: The purpose of this tournament is to allow graduates who lost the ability to compete in the 2020 AMTA season due to COVID-19 one last AMTA competition. As such, preference will be given in the registration and assisted team formation processes to those graduates whose seasons were cut short.

Priority Registrant: A person is eligible to compete at the One Last Time tournament and qualifies as a Priority Registrant if and only if the person:

- (a) graduated from an undergraduate institution during the Fall of 2019, Spring of 2020, or Summer of 2020; and
- (b) was listed on an AMTA roster for the 2020 competitive season for an institution that:
 - (a) qualified for the 2020 National Championship Tournament;
 - (b) qualified for the Princeton, Memphis, or Greenville Opening Round Championship Series tournaments; or
 - (c) were otherwise prevented from competing at an Opening Round Championship Series tournament as a result of travel restrictions related to COVID-19.

Non-Priority Registrant: A person is eligible to compete for the One Last Time tournament and qualifies as a Non-Priority Registrant if and only if the person:

- (a) graduated from an undergraduate institution during the Fall of 2019, Spring of 2020, or Summer of 2020; and
- (b) was listed on an AMTA roster for the 2020 competitive season for an institution not covered under the Priority Registrant section above.

AMTA hopes to allow all graduated seniors that wish to compete in this tournament an opportunity to do so. However, Non-Priority Registrants are not guaranteed an opportunity to compete in One Last Time.

Overcapacity of Registration: In the event that there are too many registrants to reasonably accommodate, Priority Registrants will be given preference in the assignment of team numbers and in the assisted team formation process. Teams consisting of a mix of Priority and Non-Priority Registrants will be moved to the bottom of the preference list and ranked according to the number of Priority Registrants on the team, with time and date of registration acting as a tie breaker (earlier registration wins the tie). Individual Non-Priority Registrants and teams consisting completely of Non-Priority Registrants will be moved to a waitlist. After all individual Priority Registrants and all teams containing Priority Registrants have been added to the field, individuals and teams from the waitlist will be added until the field is full.

Termination of Future Eligibility: Any person who competes at the One Last Time tournament permanently terminates eligibility for any future AMTA competitions, unless otherwise indicated by the competition rules.

Check back with these requirements as the registration process occurs. AMTA may alter these requirements depending on the number of registrations received. AMTA is working to live stream many of the trials so that those who are not eligible to compete or want to cheer on their graduates may do so.
